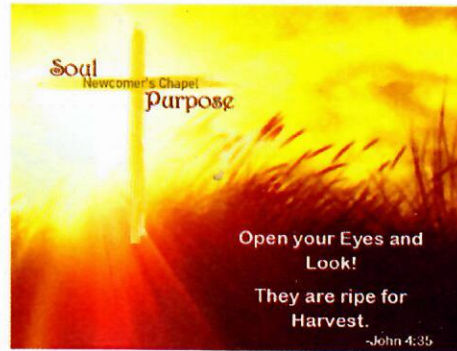


Pastor's Report
